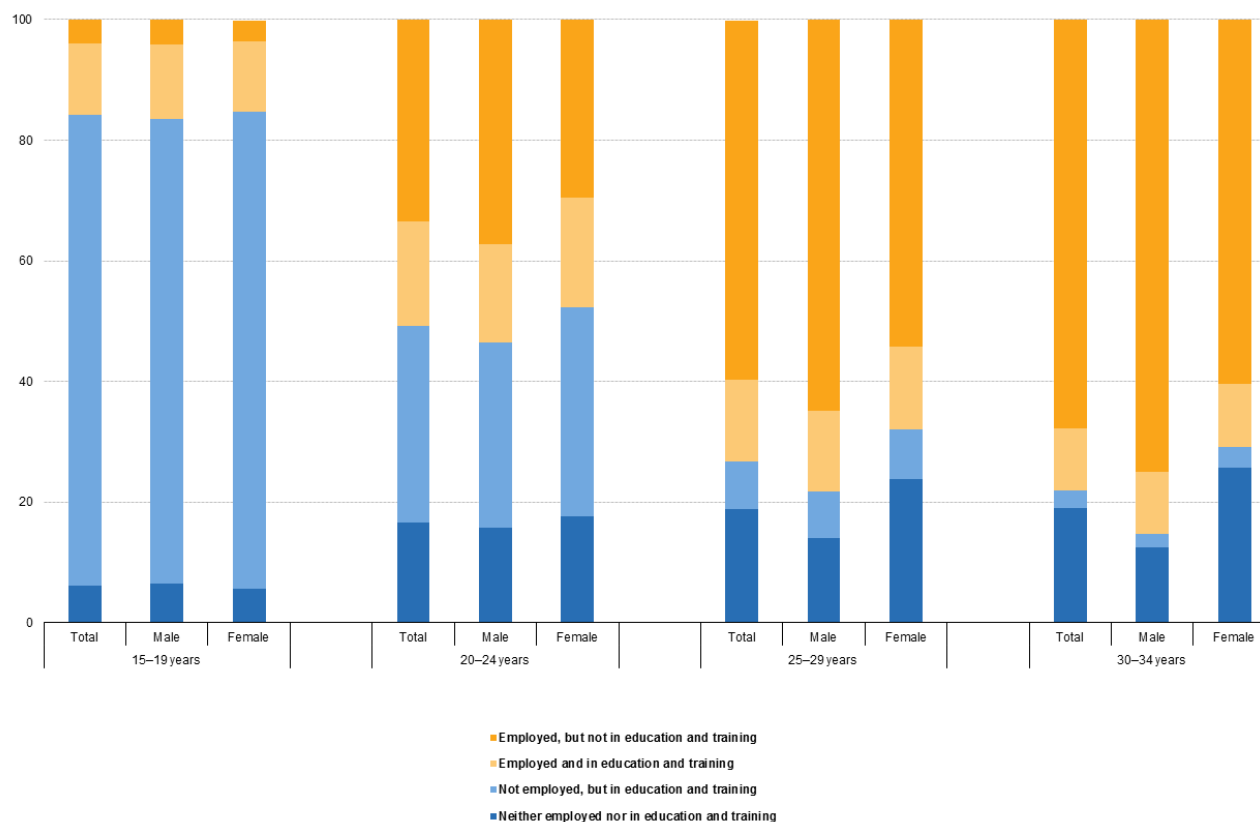


Key objectives of youth policy
