

Engraulis encrasicolus




Annual catches of sardine



Average size and biomass anchovy







Average size of commercial catches *E. encrasicolus* (cm)

Average size and biomass sardine







Biomass of S. pilchardus estimated by Echosurvey

Italian small pelagic fleet




Small pelagic catches (anchovy+sardine)/total

Technical measures years 2016 - 2017

List of the authorized boats for this fishing with the limit number of those operating in 2014

Limit of 180 fishing days/year and maximum 144 days/year for each target species

Closing of the coastal zone within 6 miles for 6 months/year

Stop of fishing activities minimum 15 days/year for each species

Catch limit of 112.700 tons/year, corresponding to the total catches in 2014

Conceivable measures in the three-year period

2018 - 2020

- limited and gradual reduction of catches compared to the current catch limits
- limited and gradual reduction of maximum fishing days/year compared to the current ones
- temporal extension of the closure of the coastal zone within 6 miles all year long



Limits of the Commission proposal

It has not considered the opinion provided by MEDAC

It is lacking at the moment of a socio-economic impact assessment

The hypothesised effects of the regulation are not tolerable by the fishing companies
