



OUTLOOK 2019 AND 2020

- The Commission will closely monitor the developments on the ground, and propose further action as necessary (→ need to keep flexibility)
- The Draft Budgets will integrate the budgetary implications of the Commission proposals adopted so far
- The financial programming for 2019 and 2020 indicates continued high funding levels for migration
- Next step: Draft Budget 2019 and Draft Amending Budget 3 to the General Budget 2018: 23 May
