### **Presentation by Commissioner Phil Hogan, responsible for agriculture and rural development, of the legislative proposals for the CAP 2021-2027**



Commissioner Phil Hogan will present three legislative proposals on the reform of the Common, Agricultural Policy (CAP) for the period 2021-2027 adopted by the College on 1 June 2018. According to the Commission the CAP at heart remains a policy designed to support European farmers and ensure Europe's food security, while ensuring a resilient, sustainable and competitive agricultural sector. The proposals are a follow-up of Commission's communication on "The Future of Food and Farming" to which the AGRI committee responded with the adoption of the own initiative report prepared by Herbert Dorfmann (EPP, IT).
