COMP 1 on Citation (1)

AMs 1 (Costa), 2 (Lybacka, Ward, Pavel)

having regard to Articles 26, 53 *and 165* of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (TFEU);

COMP 2 on Recital B

AMs 6 (Kammerevert), 7 (Lybacka, Ward, Costa, Pavel)

Whereas mutual recognition of diplomas and the outcomes of learning periods abroad enables Member States to intensify and accelerate their cooperation in education and training, and illustrates the concrete benefit of EU cooperation to citizens;

COMP 3 on Recital C

AMs 10 (Kammerevert), 11 (Lybacka, Ward, Costa, Pavel)

whereas improving recognition procedures for higher education and upper secondary education diplomas *as well as for the outcomes of learning periods abroad* is a prerequisite for the establishment of a European Education Area by 2025;

COMP 4 on paragraph 1

AMs 18 (Kammerevert), 19 (Lybacka, Ward, Costa, Pavel), 30 (Lybacka, Ward, Costa, Pavel), 32 (Giménez Barbat), 33 (Giménez Barbat),

1. Calls on Member States to make a political commitment and put in place mechanisms to automatically mutually recognise higher education and upper secondary qualifications, as well as the outcomes of learning periods abroad, in line with the objectives of the European Education Area; calls on the European Commission to support achieving this objective by fostering mutual learning and exchange of good practice, such as the regular issuing of "statements of comparability" of upper secondary school diplomas and the consistent use of the ECTS grading table.

COMP 5 on paragraph 2

AMs 21 (Kammerevert), 29 (Costa), 36 (Adinolfi)

2. Asks Member States to increase transnational cooperation, make use of new technologies in order to increase efficiency, reduce costs, improve transparency and build trust to that end with a view to take advantage of the educational and job opportunities stemming from the internal market; stresses also the need to work together with the European Commission to effectively develop and put in place the European student card serving the aim of facilitating the mutual recognition of diplomas and learning periods abroad, while reducing administrative burdens and costs for students and education institutes.

COMP 6 on paragraph 4

AMs 26 (Lybacka, Ward, Costa, Pavel), 27 (Costa), 28 (Sojdrová)

4. Calls on Member States to put in place mechanisms facilitating the automatic mutual recognition of diplomas and outcomes of learning periods *abroad* by 2025 in line with the objectives of the European Education Area *and building on existing frameworks, including the EU key competences framework; stresses in this regard also the importance of mutual links and complementarity between the European Education Area and the European Higher Education Area.*

Oral amendments

Having regard to the 2012 Bucharest Communique where all EHEA Ministers committed to the long-term goal of automatic recognition of comparable diplomas and degrees;

Oral AM 2:

Calls on Recommends Member States to ensure that in order to achieve automatic mutual recognition of diplomas and to have fair access to higher education institutions all European students are entitled to attend upper secondary education under the same conditions as nationals of that country, by having the right to be placed in a class with their own age group, at the equivalent level to their class in their country of origin, regardless of their language level:
