The Coordinators took note of the views of the EP Legal Service regarding the feasibility and legal basis of the establishment of a blacklist of stakeholders who refuse EP invitations to attend a public hearing.

The secretariat has been asked to check whether the companies that refused the invitations have an access badge. If so, a letter will be sent to the Quaestors in order to request the withdrawal of the badges.
