The European Parliament Special Committee on Financial Crimes, Tax Evasion and Tax Avoidance (TAX3) is organising a parliamentary hearing on "Golden visas and other national schemes providing tax privileges (free ports, special economic zones)" for Monday, 15 October 2018, from 3 pm to 6.30 pm, in room JAN 6Q2.

The hearing will be structured in two panels. The first panel, at which your participation will be much welcomed, will be devoted to discuss risks and vulnerabilities in the area of money laundering linked to residence by investment schemes.
