The European External Action Service (EEAS) is a functionally autonomous body of the European Union, separate from the General Secretariat of the Council and from the Commission. It is treated as an institution for the purposes of the Financial Regulation and therefore subject to the procedure of discharge provided for in Article 319 of the TFEU and in Article 263 of the Financial Regulation.

It is placed under the authority of the High Representative / Vice-President (HRVP) of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy, Ms Federica Mogherini, who is invited to the CONT meeting for a discharge hearing with Members on the implementation of EEAS budget and activities during the financial year 2017.

In accordance with the timetable for the discharge procedure, the written questions addressed to the EEAS were sent on 6 September 2018. The answers received from the EEAS were e-mailed to the CONT Members on 8 October 2018 and will be available on the CONT website.

The questionnaire mainly deals with the following issues: the EEAS building policy throughout the world, the breakdown of various costs, the evolution of human resources as well as the follow-up of previous discharge procedures.

According to the findings of the ECA related to Chapter 10 'Administration', the audit evidence indicates that the level of error in spending was not material and the testing of transactions produced an estimated overall level of error of 0,5%. The Court did not identify any specific issues concerning the EEAS.

The "Global Europe" transactions subject to audit by the ECA in 2017 represent EUR 9.8 billion:

- Development Cooperation Instrument: EUR 2.7 billion;
- European Neighbourhood Instrument: EUR 2 billion;
- Humanitarian aid: EUR 2.1 billion;
- Instrument for Pre accession Assistance: EUR 1.6 billion;
- Other actions and programmes: EUR 1.4 billion.

- The ECA's 2017 Annual Report, Chapters 1, 2 and 9;
- The Commission's follow-up report COM (2018) 545 final;
- The Annual Activity Reports of DGs DEVCO.

In accordance with the timetable for the discharge procedure, the written questions for this meeting were sent to the Commission on 25 October 2017 and e-mailed to Members on the same day. Questions concern, in particular, the following issues: residual error rate study; management of investment facilities; African peace facility; external dimension of the migration policy and External Assistance and Management Report (EAMR).

The Secretariat expects to receive the answers from the Commission on 6 November 2018 and email them to Members on the same day, these will be available on the <u>CONT website</u>.

The European Development Fund (EDF) is the main instrument for providing European Union aid for development cooperation to the African, Caribbean and Pacific States and Overseas Countries and Territories. The EDFs are funded by the Member States, governed by their own financial regulations and managed outside the framework of the EU general budget.

Following the usual procedure, Members submitted their written questions related to the 2017 EDF discharge to the rapporteur on 23 October 2018. The questions were sent to the European Commission on the same day. The replies from the European Commission should be e-mailed to CONT Members on 6 November 2018 and will be available on the CONT website.

The questionnaire focus on, *inter alia*, the financial support to the African and Security Architecture; the evolution of the EU trust fund for Africa; the level of error rate and the nature of errors; the efficiency of the implemented controls and evaluation tools.

According to the findings of the ECA 2017 Annual Report related to the activities funded by the 8th, 9th, 10th and 11th EDFs (JO C 357 of 4.10.2018), the expenditure for the financial year 2017 is materially affected by error and the testing of transactions produced an estimated overall level of error of 4,5%.

The written replies were emailed to CONT Members on 5 November 2018 and will be made available on the CONT website.

The outcome of this exchange of views will be taken into consideration within the EDF discharge procedure.
