




Cultural Heritage in EU R&I framework programs (2007-2013)





CH in Horizon 2020 – achievements and challenges

- **Increased thematic richness:** for example topics on *CH digitisation*, advanced materials, cultural and creative industries, cultural tourism, cultural landscapes, *CH* and urban regeneration, cultural literacy, conflict heritage, endangered cultural heritage, participatory management of *CH*, etc.
- Funding doubled compared to FP7 (€500-560 million against €286 million)

BUT

- Terrible success rate: well under the average 12% of Horizon 2020
- Fragmentation and lack of a holistic EU approach

Cultural Heritage intervention area

- Broad Lines
- Heritage studies and sciences, with cutting edge technologies including digital ones;
- Access to and sharing of cultural heritage, with innovative patterns and uses;
- Connect cultural heritage with emerging creative sectors;
- The contribution of cultural heritage to sustainable development through preservation and regeneration of cultural landscapes, with the EU as a laboratory for heritage-based innovation;
- Protection, preservation and restoration of cultural heritage and languages with the use of cutting edge technologies including digital;
- Influence of traditions, behavioural patterns, perceptions and beliefs on values and sense of belonging.
