

"In Between" project:" (by European Network Remembrance and Solidarity, Poland, 2016/2017/2018)

• The "In Between?" project is an educational project about stories, pictures and history, but it is also a project about identity. Participating students are given the opportunity to learn in a workshop how to collect and document oral stories. After that, they travel to borderland regions using the visual material resulting from the workshop to show it to representatives of local communities on both sides of the borders and to discuss with them about the common history and its perception. They experience their cultural and historical identity in a wider European context beyond

national borders.





Network of towns "Se souvenir de l'avenir" (by Loches municipality, France, 2017/18)

Dynamic and sustainable network of towns set up between municipalities coming from more than 20 countries and involving thousands of citizens to make them feel that they have a common European identity uniting them. Large scale citizens' meetings are organised including historical ceremonies but also workshops for young citizens giving participants the opportunity to experiencie European identity at the local level.
