ECON-TAX3 Public Hearing on a "Cum Ex scandal: financial crime and the loopholes in the current legal framework" on 26 November 2018

Dear Mr Spengel,

In my capacity as Chair of the Committee on Economic and Monetary Affairs (ECON) of the European Parliament I have the pleasure of inviting you to participate as a speaker in a joint hearing of ECON and TAX3 (Special Committee on Financial Crimes, Tax Evasion and Tax Avoidance) Committees on a "Cum Ex scandal: financial crime and the loopholes in the current legal framework" which will take place on Monday, 26 November 2018 from 19h00 to 20h30 in Parliament's premises in Brussels (room PHS 3C050).

The purpose of this hearing is to examine a recent revelation of the CumEx files, which has shown that over 55bn EUR have been defrauded through various schemes. This hearing will aim to examine the existing loopholes and financial crimes following the above-mentioned scandal.

Members of both ECON and TAX3 Committees would be interested in hearing your opinion and experience on this matter. I would like to ask you to make an initial statement of a maximum of 5 minutes in which you could give your views on the topic discussed. After the opening statements, the invited speakers will be expected to engage in an exchange of views with Members of the ECON and TAX3 Committees.

Please note that the reimbursement claim and supporting documents must be sent within six months of the hearing.
