

Iga Magda is Associate Professor at the Warsaw School of Economics and Vice President of the Institute for Structural Research (IBS) in Warsaw. Previously she worked at the Ministry of Labour and Social Policy, coordinating research projects and participating in the EU and OECD working parties on employment and social affairs. She was also a visiting researcher at ISER, University of Essex and CReAM at University College London.

Her work is centered on labour economics, in particular wage and income inequalities, human capital, gender gaps, family policies and non standard employment.

Currently she coordinates an international project “Youth Employment PartnerSHIP”, in which researchers from Poland, Hungary, Italy and Spain evaluate how effectively young people are supported on the labour market and assess which interventions have the potential to boost outreach to inactive, unregistered youth (<http://yepartnership.ibs.org.pl/>).
