## Votes

### Common organisation of the markets (CMO)/Amending Regulation



The series of important votes on the CAP post-2020 reform package will begin on 1 April with a vote on the draft report prepared by Eric Andrieu (S&D, FR) on the CMO/Amending Regulation. In addition to the 109 amendments proposed by the rapporteur to the Commission proposal, 687 amendments have been tabled by Members, and a further 92 amendments by the four opinion-giving committees. In order to reach a coherent position and to facilitate the vote, the rapporteur has negotiated 61 compromise amendments. The amendments also concern parts of the current CMO Regulation that are not amended by the Commission's proposal.

### Establishing rules on support for strategic plans to be drawn up by Member States under the Common agricultural policy (CAP Strategic Plans)



On 2 April Members will continue with the vote on the draft report prepared by Esther Herranz García (EPP, ES) on CAP Strategic Plans. 5253 amendments have been tabled by Members, and a further 670 by the six opinion-giving committees. In order to reach a coherent position and to facilitate the vote, the rapporteur has negotiated over 130 compromise amendments.
