## Short CV's of the experts

### Clara ULRICH



Deputy Head of Science, Ifremer (France)  
(before Professor; DTU Aqua, Denmark)

Clara Ulrich holds a PhD in Agronomy from Agrocampus Ouest, Rennes, and worked on various European fisheries management topics during the past 20 years.

Until August 2019, Clara Ulrich was acting as Professor for fisheries management at the National Institute for Aquatic Resources, Technical University of Denmark ([DTU Aqua](http://www.dtu.dk)), working on the modelling and management of mixed demersal fisheries including discard issues. She was the coordinator of the H2020 project DiscardLess (2015-2019) <http://www.discardless.eu>.

Her new place of work, the scientific directorate of [Ifremer](http://www.ifremer.fr), leads the scientific strategy of ensuring its multidisciplinary, quality, and policy relevance. Here, Clara Ulrich mainly deals with aspects linked to ecosystem-based fisheries management and support to national and European fisheries policies. In the past, Clara Ulrich authored [several EP studies](#).

She is also the Chair of the European Commission's Scientific, Technical and Economic Committee for Fisheries (STECF).

### Bertrand LE GALLIC



Associate Professor in Economics, University of Brest, UMR AMURE (France)

Bertrand Le Gallic holds a PhD in Marine Resources Economics. He moved in 2005 from OECD's fisheries division to the University of Brest.

Bertrand Le Gallic has been involved in four EU research framework projects, two Interreg projects and several national research projects, where he was in charge of the leading of work packages, especially dealing with economic data collection and policy analysis. In 2017, he also led a [study for the EP](#) on impacts of Brexit on trade in the EU seafood sector. From 2015 to 2019, Bertrand Le Gallic was also the President of the Economic Association of Fisheries Economists (EAFE).
