Conclusion of the Agreement in the form of an exchange of letters between the European Union and Ukraine amending the trade preferences for poultry meat and poultry meat preparations provided for by the Association Agreement between the European Union and the European Atomic Energy Community and their Member States, of the one part, and Ukraine, of the other part



Members will discuss the opinion prepared by Mr Zbigniew Kuźmiuk (ECR, PL) on the conclusion of the above-mentioned agreement with the Ukraine. The agreed solution aims to stop the rising duty free imports of a new type of poultry cut, which can, after minimal transformation, be marketed as poultry breast. The lead committee for this report is INTA.

Conclusion of an agreement with the United States of America on the Allocation to the United States of a Share in the Tariff Rate Quota provided for by Regulation (EC) No 617/2009 of 13 July 2009 opening an autonomous tariff quota for imports of high-quality beef



Members will discuss the opinion prepared by Mr Herbert Dorfmann (EPP, IT) on the conclusion of the above-mentioned Agreement with the US. The Agreement aims to end a long-standing WTO dispute on “hormone beef” by reallocating a higher share of the existing Tariff Rate Quota for high quality beef to the US.
