    - enables people to lead better lives, and makes the world a better place.

# Affordable air travel creates a positive loop for economic prosperity

- Facilitates labour mobility
  - competitivity depends on mobility large projects need mobility
- Expands business travel, notably for SMEs
  - A more connected business world generates more investment and employment opportunities, interregional linkages, investment is spurred to area
- Accelerates local economy growth and regional development, territorial cohesion
  - Linking remote areas to the core
  - Connect secondary airports direct job creation
- Enables research, innovation and educational mobility critical for Erasmus exchanges
- Allows leisure and cultural tourism to expand and take new forms



# LCCs provide an immediate and more sustainable option for travel than rail or road in many European regions...

- Level of emissions by passenger are much lower than for travel by car (while railway infrastructure is old and obsolete) and
- Air travel avoids natural limitations brought by infrastructure and geography:
  - less infrastructure needed, with less consumption of steel and energy to produce it, than most other "greener" means of transport
  - less impact on preserving biodiversity, not affecting minimal vital habitats needed by other species
  - less traffic generated pollution , with
  - significant better track record of safety.

# ... while also embarking on significant projects to preserve this advantage going further

## Main commitments:

- Ensure the most efficient usage of the capacity put in place
- Neutralize our carbon footprint
- Use more efficient aircraft and ensure early adoption of renewable fuels when available



## How people of Blue Air make it happen every day

- Put in place strong analytical capabilities to ensure that we have at least 90% load factor on all our flights
- 2. Project in progress to replace the older generation aircraft by end of 2020
- 3. Joint effort of digital team and pilots to optimize fuel consumption for each flight
- 4. Technology fluency initiative to digitalize our operations and passenger journey
