The Secretariat-General of the European Commission is one of the central services of the European Commission, facilitating its smooth and effective functioning and providing strategic direction.

It is the President's department, at the service of the President, the College and the other Commission departments. It manages the collegial decision-making process and ensures the alignment of EU policies with the political priorities of the Commission. In agreement with the President, the Secretariat-General provides support to the Vice-Presidents in the performance of their role.

According to the annual activity report of the Secretary General "2018 was a crucial year to drive forward the implementation of the political priorities of the Juncker Commission. The Secretariat-General played a key role in a number of aspects of the Commission's work, from the proposals on the future long-term budget for the Union, to the preparedness work linked to the United Kingdom's withdrawal from the European Union. In order to be better prepared for the new challenges ahead, the Secretariat-General's organisation chart underwent major changes during the reporting year. The new structure properly conveys the principles underpinning the mission statement of the Secretariat-General and its different service roles and better reflects the priorities of the Commission as well as the policies where the Secretariat-General is in the lead." - Other Members will question the Commission and/or the Court;
- Closing remarks by the CONT Rapporteur.

4. 2017 DISCHARGE: EUROPEAN ASYLUM SUPPORT OFFICE (EASO)

On 23 October 2019, the EP refused to grant the Executive Director of the European Asylum Support Office discharge for the financial year 2017.

Following such refusal, the EP's Rules of Procedure foresee that "a formal proposal to close the accounts for the year in question shall be submitted at a subsequent part-session" (Annex V, Article 5 (2) (b)).

The Rapporteur tabled a motion for decision to close the accounts of EASO. The motion for decision has been circulated to Members on 6 November 2019.

- short presentation by the Vice-President responsible for budgetary affairs;
- brief presentation by the Secretary-General of the answers to the written questions;
- presentation by the Internal Auditor of the European Parliament of his 2018 annual report;
- statement and oral questions by the Rapporteur;
- Q&A session with other Members;
- closing remarks by the Rapporteur.
