
RĪGA 2014 in figures

- 12 000 participants from 100 culture institutions
- 1900 artists and organisations in realisation
- More than 1,5 million event-visitors
- 6,2 million reach of TV broadcasts
- 63% free of charge events
- 18,9% tourist growth
- 3700 volunteers



RĪGA 2014 programme in figures

- Diverse programme high culture and grass routs projects
- World Choir Games 73 countries, 460 choirs, 27 000 participants, 1600 organisers from 15 countries
- Former KGB House 45 000 visitors during 5 months
- Concert BORN in RIGA broadcasted in 9 countries
- European Film Awards broadcasted in 40 countries
- New creations operas, films, books, festivals, expositions in museums, CDs, etc.
