Revision of the Package Travel Directive

- → Parliament has opportunity to bring clarity and fairness, take away room for interpretation, and afford robust and effective consumer protection
- → Online travel agents agree to be covered for any dynamic package sold at an <u>inclusive</u> price
- → Further extension of scope is arbitrary and will lead to competitive distortion to the disadvantage of travel agents that are active across the Single Market
- → Yet, most important risk that of airline insolvency is again NOT addressed



ETTSA: Suggested improvements

- → Amend definition of « package » to include combinations sold in one transaction and at an **inclusive** (not total) price
- → Remove provisions on « assisted travel arrangements », and instead cover real risk of airline insolvency
- → Maintain helpful exemption for business travel transactions
- → Clarify link between PTD and Air Passenger Rights Regulation
- → Make insolvency protection levels subject to the real risk
- → Create right for organisers to participate in any national scheme
