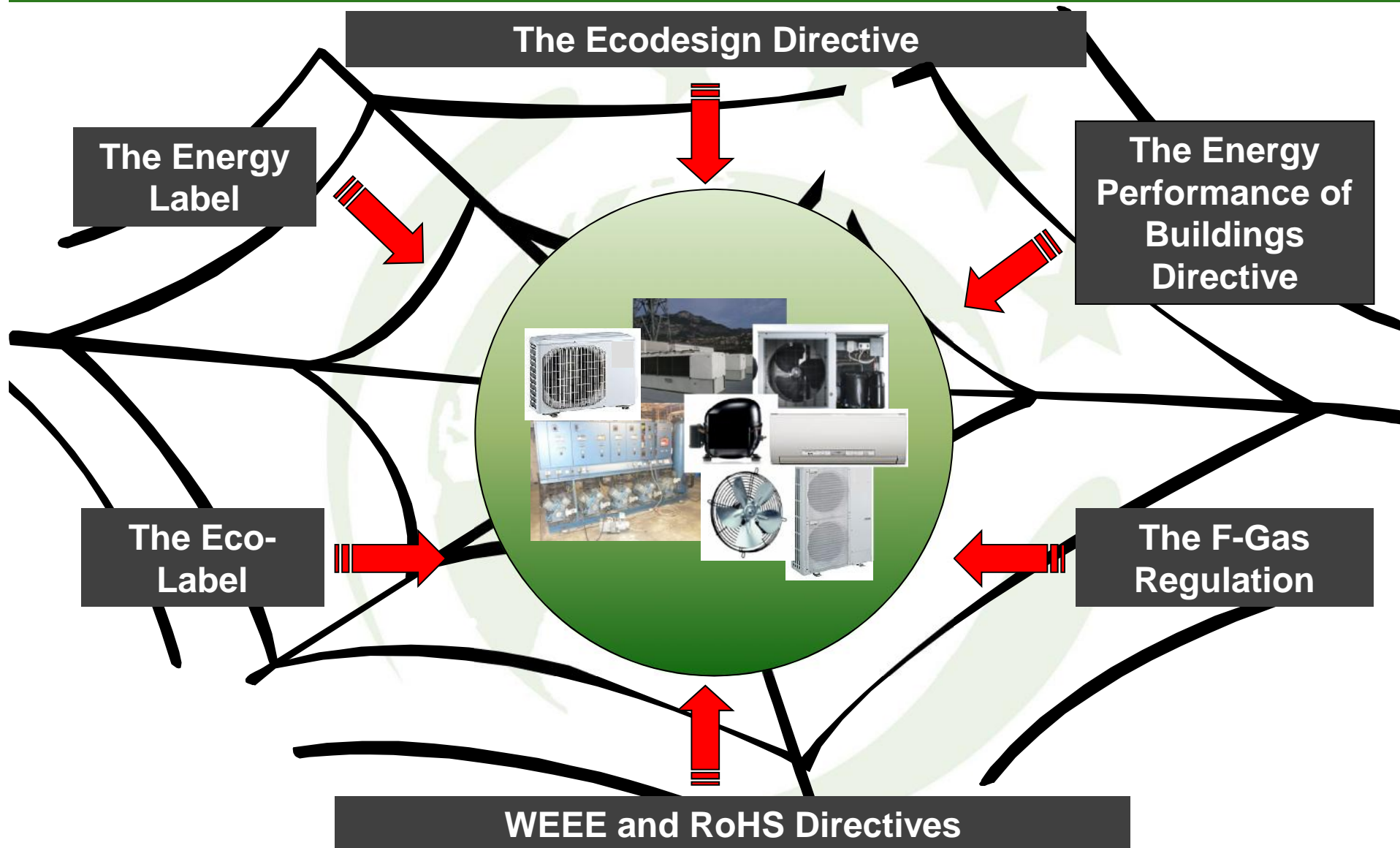

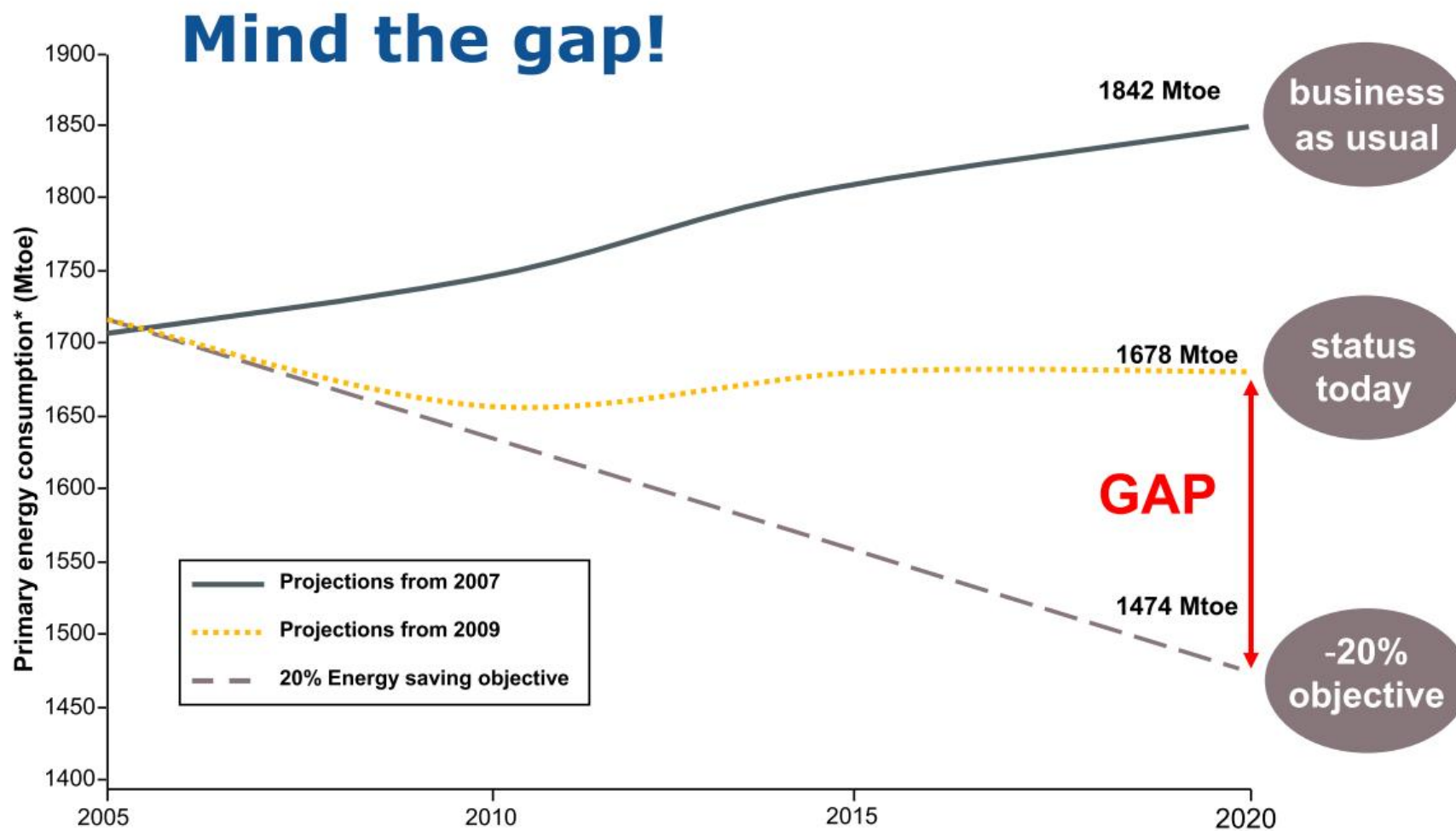
Heating and Cooling: Essential to daily life

Market Surveillance is essential, to:

1. **Achieve** the EU's climate and energy goals
2. **Bridge the gap** to achieve energy efficiency targets
3. **Ensure** a level playing field for industry



Improvements are required:

- Market surveillance for **environmental legislation** such as ecodesign and energy labelling (www.ecoplant.eu)
- Cooperation of Market Surveillance Authorities:
 - Sharing and mutual recognition of data
 - Technical expertise
 - Accredited test laboratories



Market Surveillance Regulation : A Positive Development

EPEE supports:

1. The establishment of the European Market Surveillance Forum
 2. Sanctions and penalties for non-compliant market actors
 3. The use of the ICSMS system to deliver quick information
 4. Accredited reference laboratories
