1.) PARTIAL ACCESS

- Art 1 + 4f Proposal:

Partial access to profession if:

- Differences are so large that problem cannot be solved by 'normal' compensatory measures

SO: first apply compensatory measures to be FULLY recognized

- Professional activity can be separated so that it can be exercised as autonomous activity in home MS

SO: no artificial activities

Possible problems:

- More confusion for consumers
- Fragmentation of markets

Safeguards / benefits:

- More free movement
- Profession will be carried out under home state title

Safeguards:

- Partial access may be refused by overriding reasons of general interest (if objective pursued is secured and proportional)

2.) PARTIAL QUALIFICATION

- Extension scope directive
- Recognition of traineeships pursued in other MS
- Directive not about 'how' to obtain a diploma (MS) but only about recognition
 - e.g. lawyers: always substantial differences-> not necessarily for other professions

Bologna: Lisbon Recognition Convention

- Recognition unless substantial differences
- EU law prevails
