### Directive on credit servicers and credit purchasers

From **15:00 to 16:00**, ECON Members will discuss the amendments tabled to the draft report submitted by the Co-Rapporteurs Esther de Lange (EPP/NL) and Irene Tinagli (S&D/IT) on Part A of the Directive on Non-Performing Loans (NPLs). This part relates to requirements applicable to credit servicers and credit purchasers (so-called "Secondary markets"). Overall, Members tabled 203 amendments addressing a wide range of issues. These cover, among others, the scope of the Directive, the level of consumer protection, cross-border activities, requirements for credit purchasers, and the level of harmonisation.
