1. CHAIR'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

Following a letter of CCC Chair Tajani on the matter, the Chair will write to the Secretary General to signal that the BUDG committee is ready to swiftly process the necessary transfer to recruit additional contract agents in view of the constitution of five new temporary committees.

2. POINTS FOR DECISION

2.1. Appointment of co-rapporteurs (EPP request)

The coordinators decided that the allocation of the report on the Solvency Support Instrument to the EPP and Renew groups in co-rapporteurship will be for 1,5 points per group. They also agreed to review the points system at the mid-point of the term, as appropriate.

2.2. Budget 2021 - Calendar and interinstitutional meetings

The coordinators endorsed the revised calendar for the budgetary procedure 2021 - including the postponement of the budgetary trilogue and the payments meeting to September - and mandated the Chair to agree on the exact dates of the modified pragmatic calendar with Commission and Council by an exchange of letters.

The deadlines for budgetary amendments will be set in weeks 39 and 40 in agreement with the plenary services.

2.3. Budget 2021 - Section I - European Parliament

The coordinators and the rapporteur exchanged views on the Commission proposal in the Draft Budget 2021 regarding the European Parliament estimates.
