3. <u>DECISIONS ON URGENT MATTERS</u>

3.1 Preliminary agreement reached with AGRI on the joint Farm to Fork Strategy INI

Decision taken:

Coordinators mandated the secretariat to finalise the agreement with AGRI on the joint Farm to Fork Strategy INI, making sure that the agreement confirms ENVI's core competence on greenhouse gas emissions.

- 3.2 Decision on how to deal with ENVI opinions on the following reports:
 - JURI INI on Sustainable corporate governance
 - JURI INL on Corporate due diligence and corporate accountability

Decision taken:

In view of the JURI timetable and the workload situation, Coordinators decided to do an opinion in a swift procedure in EN only for the JURI INI on "Sustainable corporate governance" and not to do an opinion for the JURI legislative INL on "Corporate due diligence and corporate accountability".

3.3 Experts for the public hearing on Brexit

Decision taken:

Coordinators endorsed the proposed title, the speakers and the names in reserve who should be invited should some of the original invitees prove to be unavailable.

3.4 Withdrawal by the Commission of proposals on cloning - potential steps

Decision taken:

Coordinators agreed with the suggested approach to write a letter to the Commission, on behalf of the coordinators of both AGRI and ENVI committees, expressing the political disagreement with the foreseen withdrawal and underlining that this issue cannot be left unregulated.

4. <u>EXCHANGE OF VIEWS WITH MRS SANDRA GALLINA, DEPUTY</u> DIRECTOR-GENERAL OF DG SANTE, ON THE VACCINES STRATEGY

Decision taken:

As a follow-up to the exchange of view in the ENVI committee on 7 September and the joint hearing with ITRE on 22 September, coordinators had an exchange of views with Ms. Gallina on the latest developments on vaccines and decided that they will come back to the issue.
