

Elisabete Weiderpass, MD, MSc, PhD, is a Brazilian cancer researcher who is a naturalized Swedish and Finnish citizen. She is an expert in cancer epidemiology and cancer prevention.

In January 2019, Dr Weiderpass took office as elected Director of the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC, www.iarc.fr), the specialized cancer agency of the World Health Organization (WHO), based in Lyon, France. The Agency welcomes about 350 staff dedicated to cancer research. Its membership and governance is made up of 26 countries (or 'Participating States').

Dr Weiderpass formerly served as Head of the Genetic Epidemiology Group at the Folkhälsan Research Center in Helsinki, Finland (2007-2018) and as Head of the Research Department at the Cancer Registry in Oslo, Norway (2015-2018). She was a Professor of Medical Epidemiology at the Karolinska Institutet in Stockholm, Sweden (2011-2018), and a Professor of Cancer Epidemiology at the Arctic University in Tromsø, Norway (2011-2018). She also held Adjunct Professorship positions in Cancer Epidemiology in Brazil, China, and the Islamic Republic of Iran.

Dr Weiderpass was a Visiting Professor in several institutes and universities in Kuwait, PR China, Finland and in the Islamic Republic of Iran (2016-1018). Since 2019, Dr Weiderpass is a Visiting Adjunct Professor in Yale School of Public Health (New Haven, Connecticut, USA).

She has authored over 800 scientific publications in peer-reviewed international journals.
