European Education Area = aims

- spending time <u>studying abroad</u> should become the norm;
- school and higher education <u>qualifications should be recognized</u> across the Member States;
- it should be standard for people to know two foreign languages in addition to their mother tongue;
- everyone should be able to access <u>high-quality education</u>, irrespective of their socio-economic background;
- people should have a strong sense of their <u>identity</u> as <u>Europeans</u>, of Europe's cultural heritage and of its diversity.



European University Initiative – 2017 (Gothenburg)

- Transnational Alliances = Universities of the future
- Partners from all types of HEI and broad geographical scope
- Long term strategy focused on sustainability = pilot projects
- Joint governance
- Offer student-centered curricula jointly delivered across inter-university campuses
- Interdisciplinary teams to tackle biggest challenges facing Europe






