In Europe and worldwide, Animals’ Angels are there with the animals on the roads, at animal markets, at border control points or at slaughterhouses. The teams document shortcomings, file complaints and report them, demanding compliance with existing animal welfare regulations. Where this protection is not sufficiently regulated, Animals’ Angels is committed to creating better standards. The teams collaborate with the authorities based on mutual trust. Animals’ Angels has the vision of a new human-animal relationship that respects the dignity of animals and their right to life.
