Judith Freedman

Judith Freedman is Pinsent Masons Professor of Taxation Law and Policy at the University of Oxford. From 2001-2019 she was the inaugural statutory Professor of Taxation Law at Oxford University Law Faculty and she was one of the founders of the Oxford University Centre for Business Taxation Centre.

She was a member of the Aaronson General Anti-Avoidance Rule Study Group and has served on many other policy committees.

In 2020, she was appointed to the Board of the UK Office of Tax Simplification. She is Chair of the Tax Law Review Committee of the Institute of Fiscal Studies. Judith is general editor of the British Tax Review as well as being on the editorial boards of several other journals. Prof. Freedman was appointed a CBE for her services to tax research and in January 2015 as an Honorary Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Taxation.

She was elected a Fellow of the British Academy in 2016. She is speaking only in her own capacity today.
