3.1 Request of Legal Service opinion on the authorisation of chromium trioxide

<u>Decision taken:</u> Coordinators had an exchange of views with the Commission on its

decision granting authorisation for certain uses of chromium trioxide. On the basis of a legal opinion, which was presented by the Legal Service, a majority of coordinators decided to bring the matter to the attention of the JURI Committee and to recommend to the JURI Committee that an action for annulment should be brought against the Commission decision, taking into account the final judgement by the ECJ on the appeal brought by the Commission in case T-837/16 (Sweden v Commission) expected end of February.

3.2 European Semester - Inter-parliamentary Conference on Stability, Economic Coordination and Governance in the European Union

<u>Decision taken:</u> Coordinators took note of the updated programme of the EPW 2021

and decided to invite Laurence Boone, OECD Chief Economist, as speaker to the ICM co-organised by ENVI next to the Commission

representative proposed by the Portuguese Parliament.
