3. DECISIONS ON URGENT MATTERS

3.1 *Distribution of posts in ENVI for the second half of the legislature*

Decision taken: *Coordinators confirmed the status quo for the distribution of posts among the political groups and took note of the invitation to groups to either confirm the names of the MEPs currently holding these posts or to inform the Secretariat of the new names as soon as possible.*

Coordinators decided to continue the work of the Health Working Group and requested that the co-chairs come forward with a proposal for a Work Programme for 2022 for the next coordinators meeting.

3.2 *Follow-up to EMPL committee mission to Slovakia regarding marginalised Roma communities*

Decision taken: *Coordinators mandated the Chair to co-sign a joint letter with his EMPL counterpart to Commissioner Sinkevičius to bring the situation of marginalised Roma communities living on waste sites, not only in Slovakia, and the danger these sites pose to the health and lives of the concerned citizens, to his attention.*

3.2 *Relations with other committees*

3.2.1 *PETI request for an INL on transparency in medicine prices.*

Decision taken: *Coordinators mandated the Chair to respond to the PETI Chair, explaining that ENVI coordinators have taken note of the request for an legislative initiative report and have decided not to offer any follow-*

up due to the current heavy ENVI workload and to the fact that transparency issues in the pharmaceuticals sector have already been addressed in recent motions for resolutions initiated by ENVI.

3.2.2 EMPL hearing on Social and employment aspects of the Green Deal and the 'Fit for 55' package: state of play, challenges and opportunities on 28.2

Decision taken: *Coordinators took note of the deadline for political groups to submit names for the ENVI expert by Wednesday February 2 cob.*

3.2.3 Update on AGRI resolution on protection of livestock farming and wolves

Decision taken: *Coordinators mandated the Chair to respond to the AGRI chair, reiterating concerns by a large majority of coordinators on the draft resolution currently prepared by AGRI and proposing to look jointly at this issue, by organising for instance a joint hearing to assess the current situation and the sufficiency of the tools that are available to mitigate the issue. Such a joint cooperation would only stand, provided that the AGRI committee immediately suspends its work on its current draft motion for a resolution.*

Decision taken: *Coordinators took note of the discussions with FEMM on this issue.*

3.2.5 Follow-up to IMCO request for impact assessment on batteries file
