1. CHAIR'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

ECON mission to the EIB

Coordinators agreed that, given the unavailability of the rapporteur, no BUDG members would accompany the ECON delegation to the EIB in February.

Global Gateway

The Chair is to write to Commissioner Hahn to request DG BUDG to provide in the shortest delay a comprehensive note on the financing of the Global Gateway.

Update on Fit for 55 files

A background note and a concept note have been shared with the ENVI and EMPL Chairs in view of a meeting in the coming week. The notes will be sent to the President in view of further discussions.

2. POINTS FOR DECISION

2.1. Attribution of files and standing rapporteurs
