3.1 Files for reconsideration following the JUNE I Plenary votes on the Fit For 55 package – next steps in the procedure

ETS:

The Chair to confirm, in a letter to the President that:

- the item should be put to the agenda of the next plenary;
- a deadline for amendments needs to be opened in plenary.
- the ENVI committee will re-table all AMs carried in plenary to plenary.

A procedural vote to formally endorse the Coordinators' recommendation will take place in ENVI committee on 14 June.

CBAM:

The Chair to confirm, in a letter to the President that:

- the same procedure should continue and that the item should be put to the agenda of the next plenary;
- a deadline for amendments needs to be opened in plenary;
- no amendment needs to be tabled by the ENVI committee in addition to those that were already tabled.

A procedural vote to formally endorse the Coordinators' recommendation will take place in ENVI committee on 14 June.

SCF:

No action by ENVI-EMPL coordinators needed, a simple reference in the letter to the President could be included regarding the plenary agenda and the need to keep the package together.

<u>Decision taken:</u>
Coordinators decided that documents received from HERA are to be distributed to Coordinators. They also decided to invite HERA's Director General for an exchange of views after summer after the final

agreement on the Cross-border health threats file.

<u>Decision taken:</u> Coordinators decided to invite ECHA and EFSA for an exchange of views on this matter in Committee and to come back to the issue afterwards.

) COVI - request for tabling of joint oral question to plenary

Decision taken:

Coordinators decided to allow for changes to be prepared at technical level to the COVI draft OQ and once the text of the OQ has been agreed by written procedure, ENVI would co-sign the joint OQ with COVI.

) IMCO/ITRE - update discussions with IMCO and ITRE on Circular economy package

Decision taken:

Coordinators mandated the Chair to refuse IMCO's requests for exclusive competences on Articles 1, 3, 5, 14, 20, and insist on shared competence on other parts of the text, except for parts covered by exclusive competences under the batteries file. They also mandated the Chair to contact his ITRE counterpart to negotiate an agreement in line with the batteries file. Finally, coordinators mandated the chair to ask for a CCC recommendation in case the discussions with IMCO and ITRE do not lead to a successful result.

) AGRI and ITRE - Industrial Emissions Directive request - mandate to negotiate

Decision taken:

Coordinators mandated the Chair to contact his ITRE and AGRI counterparts in order to negotiate an agreement that safeguards ENVI competences and builds on past precedents.
