Coordinators' meeting of 6 December 2021 Coordinators' decisions and recommendations

- 1. Possible appointment of rapporteurs and rapporteurs for opinion
 - Possible reports: legislative and non-legislative

Implementation and delivery of Sustainable Development Goals (jointly with ENVI) *Decision:*

Report attributed to RENEW for two points

- Legislative and non-legislative opinions
- i) Amendment to the Renewable Energy Directive (RED) ITRE in the lead Decision:

Opinion attributed to EPP for one point

ii) Revision of the EU Emissions Trading Systems (ETS) - ENVI in the lead Decision:

Opinion attributed to NI

iii) Proposal for a Regulation establishing a carbon border adjustment mechanism - ENVI in the lead

Organise a follow-up discussion on EU assistance to Afghanistan and explore the possibility to invite both Commissioners Lenarcic and Urpilainen. The NGO Emergency could be invited in this context.

Decision

Organise a discussion at the next coordinators' meeting on our NDICI/GE scrutiny. Consideration should be given to the development of a methodology to ensure the proper scrutiny of the MIPs and how to improve the mechanism of Parliament's proper and timely involvement in the mobilisation of the NDICI/GE cushion.
