- regarding the working methods, Coordinators agreed to work as much as possible with consensus. If this is not possible, as a last resort, the decisions will be put to the vote in BUDG Committee.

Coordinators agreed to provide a regular opinion (in form of a letter) under Rule 56 following agreement with ENVI on the additional reassurances proposed by BUDG in the draft letter to the CCC Chair, endorsed the draft letter and mandated the Chair to send it to the CCC Chair.

- BUDG-ECON Coordinators / InvestEU arrangements for the sharing of sensitive or confidential information: as no objections were received by the deadline of Tuesday 31 January (cob), the arrangements for the sharing of sensitive or confidential information in the context of InvestEU are confirmed.
- BUDG-ECON Coordinators exchange of views on the implementation of Invest EU: as no objections were received by the deadline of Friday 10 February (cob), an exchange of views on the implementation of InvestEU will be organised in due course.
- Revision of Annex VI to the RoP BUDG input to CCC Away Day: since no objections were raised by the deadline of close of business on 6 February, the updated paper providing BUDG input on reform of Annex VI to the Rules of Procedure and committee cooperation, including the addition proposed by the Greens/EFA, was deemed approved and transmitted to the CCC Chair.
- Letter on the possible use of EU funding to build a fence at the EU external border: no large majority was reached on the wording of the letter.
- Input to the ECA work programme for 2024: based on the answers received, no audit suggestions have been sent to the CCC.
