1. EXCHANGE OF VIEWS WITH THE NEW DIRECTOR-GENERAL FOR BUDGET, EUROPEAN COMMISSION

The Coordinators held an exchange of views with the European Commission's recently appointed Director-General for the Budget, Stéphanie Riso.

2. CHAIR'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

<u>Feedback on CCC reflection day on 7 March and CCC exchange of views with</u> <u>President Metsola on 14 March</u>

On 7 March, the Chair attended a Conference of Committee Chairs (CCC) reflection day entitled "Towards a more modern and efficient Parliament', which focused on improving committee cooperation and the challenges related to proposals under Article 122 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union and the application of the urgency procedure in Parliament (Rule 163). There was a follow-up exchange of views in the CCC with President Metsola on 14 March on the same topics. The Chair conveyed the messages he had been mandated to transmit with respect to Annex VI to the Rules of Procedure and the need for Parliament to exercise its legislative and budgetary powers in a coordinated way.

3. POINTS FOR DECISION

3.1. Implications of changes in the composition of political groups

Coordinators decided to appoint Ms Keller (Renew Europe) as the Rapporteur for the 2023 Budget (Section III).

Furthermore, the Coordinators decided to ask the Committee on Constitutional Affairs for an interpretation of the Rules of Procedure to determine whether, when a Member changes political group, he/she retains any rapporteurship he/she holds prior to the change or whether a committee is required to take a fresh decision on the appointment of the rapporteur.

The Coordinators decided to invite the Chair of the InvestEU Steering Board to a BUDG-ECON meeting over the coming months and, in preparation of the meeting, to organise an in camera meeting between the InvestEU negotiating team and Mr Lamassoure, the expert appointed by the Parliament as a non-voting member of the Steering Board.

3.5. BUDG-CONT-FEMM annual meeting on gender mainstreaming in the budget (postponed from the coordinators' meeting of 1 March 2023)

The Coordinators mandated the Policy Department to prepare a briefing on national parliaments' practices regarding gender budgeting ahead of the annual BUDG-CONT-FEMM meeting on gender mainstreaming in the budget and agreed to invite speakers from the following bodies to that meeting:
