
#### **Media monitoring** (MM)

- [It] is the activity of monitoring the output of the print,
   online and broadcast media..
- ..to power the **decision-making** process of people and organizations
  - e.g., analysis of current <u>events</u>, identification of [emerging] <u>trends</u>, competitive <u>intelligence</u>, public <u>reputation</u>, brand <u>awareness</u>
- Digital humanities and strategic communication: opinions, biases, manipulation, sentiment, connections → counter-acting






### **Multilingual MM: Pipeline**





- Text

## **SELMA:** Counting diversity




#### **Deutsche Welle diversity dimensions**

### Counting diversity: Initial plan current decision

For each entity representing a **person**, we collect the following diversity properties from Wikidata:

date of birth (P569), binary sex or gender (P21), country of citizenship (P27), occupation (P106), ethnic group (P172), sexual orientation (P91), religion or worldview (P140), medical condition (P1050), educated at (P69), member of political party (P102), continent (P30).







## **Beyond SELMA: Countering disinformation**

- Foreign information manipulation and interference (FIMI)
- Tactics, techniques and procedures (TTP)
- Russian FIMI and Kremlin-related entities (KRE)
- Media monitoring and analysis w.r.t. KREs and their TTPs
- Construction of a **KRE knowledge graph** a source of "truth"
- Human-in-the-loop vs. Al-in-the-loop










#### PiniTree platform for knowledge graphs

Creation and maintenance of private/shared knowledge bases (KB)

  - Ex-Pentagon Officer: Russia's Robust Capabilities in Electronic Warfare Second to None
- Hey ChatGPT, are there any FIMI elements or propaganda TTPs used in this article?
  - Appeal to authority
  - Positive portrayal of Russian capabilities
  - Selection of information
  - Reliance on leaked documents
  - Fear appeal
  - Implicit negative portrayal of the US and Ukraine
  - Absence of counterarguments or alternative perspectives

### TTP analysis with the large language models

- Sample article #2
   https://www.bbc.com/news/world-europe-65173043

   Nato's border with Russia doubles as Finland joins
- Hey ChatGPT, are there any FIMI elements or propaganda TTPs used in this article?
  - o This article **does not** prominently employ propaganda or disinformation TTPs, still:
    - Appeal to authority
    - Framing
    - Emotional language
  - Overall, the article appears to be relatively balanced and informative, providing reactions of various parties involved

#### **Key messages**

- Various media spread **different opinions and beliefs**, incl. malicious
- Large language models can handle many "truths"
  - o Instruction tuning can make them purposely "biased" towards a task/truth
- Public and private KBs are used as authoritative sources of some truth which, in the case of MM, is "grounded" by named entity mentions in the news content, facilitating fact-checking but raising privacy risks
- Al-aided technology is there to help empower and defend democracy
  - o Is EU open for it and ready to act while still preserving its values?
