Coordinators' meeting of 26 April 2023 Coordinators' decisions and recommendations

1. Appointment of rapporteurs for opinions

- a) Proposal for a regulation of the European Parliament and of the council establishing a framework for ensuring a secure and sustainable supply of critical raw materials *Decision:* Following a decision already taken by written procedure, DEVE has requested to be associated under rule 57 with shared competences. The opinion is attributed to EPP for 1 point.
- b) EU Action Plan: Protecting and restoring marine ecosystems for sustainable and resilient fisheries

Decision: Opinion attributed to RENEW for 1 point

- c) DEVE's contribution to ENVI motion for a resolution on climate COP 28 *Decision:* DEVE's contribution to be presented in the form of amendments to be tabled by the Chair on behalf of the Committee
- d) INTA implementation report on implementation of the EU-Southern African Development Community (SADC) Economic Partnership Agreement (EPA)

 Decision: Opinion attributed to S&D for 1 point
- e) LIBE report on negotiations on a status agreement on operational activities carried out by the European Border and Coast Guard Agency (Frontex) in Mauritania *Decision:* No opinion
- f) LIBE report on the ongoing negotiations on a status agreement on operational activities carried out by the European Border and Coast Guard Agency (Frontex) in Senegal *Decision:* No opinion
- g) Proposal for a decision of the European Parliament and of the council amending Decision No 1313/2013/EU on a Union Civil Protection Mechanism Decision: No opinion

2. The use of the expertise budget

Decision: The following products will be requested:

 In-depth analysis on 'EU support for promoting access to quality education in the Sub-Saharan region - involvement of local partners

- Workshop on 'Assessment of developing countries' energy needs and priorities under a sustainable development perspective. The specific case of Africa and green hydrogen'
- Workshop on 'Enabling stronger policies against poverty and inequality in developing countries through supporting their fiscal space'

3. Follow-up to the adoption of the Policy Coherence Development report

Decision:

- The Chair is mandated, in cooperation with the Standing Rapporteur for PCD, to prepare and send a letter to the other Committee Chairs and to relevant Delegation Chairs requesting each of their Committees and Delegations to appoint a Member of the PCD Network
- A follow-up discussion will be organised to discuss the mandate of the PCD rapporteur and agree on further specific actions that could be taken.

4. Requests from groups

Decision:

• Follow-up with ENVI on the state of play regarding the preparation of the parliamentary position on the COP 16 on biodiversity in view of DEVE's possible future contribution.
