**Coordinators' meeting of 28 June 2023**  
**Coordinators' decisions and recommendations**

**1. Appointment of rapporteurs for reports and opinions**

**i) EU development cooperation in support of access to energy in developing countries**

*Decision:* The INI report is attributed to the Greens/EFA for two points

**ii) Motion for a resolution pursuant to Rule 143 of the Rules of Procedure on carrying out an audit of EU humanitarian aid to Afghanistan**

*Decision:* No action.

**iii) DROI INI on 'Shaping the global agenda on business and human rights: the EU and the UN binding instrument on Business and Human Rights'**

*Decision:* DEVE to draft a short and focused opinion. It is attributed to the Left for 1 point.

**iv) BUDG interim report on MFF revision**

*Decision:* Given the short timeline, DEVE to prepare an opinion in the form of a letter by end of August. It is attributed to Renew for 0 points.

**v) Proposal for a Council Decision on the conclusion, on behalf of the Union, of the Protocol on the implementation of the Fisheries Partnership Agreement between the European Community, on the one hand, and the Republic of Kiribati, on the other (2023-2028)**

*Decision:* DEVE to draft an opinion on the consent procedure. It is attributed to ECR for 0 points according to the rotation system.

**vi) DROI annual report on human rights and democracy in the world and the European Union's policy on the matter**

*Decision:* DEVE not to draft an opinion

**2. Policy Coherence for Development**

*Decision:* DEVE Secretariat to work on the revision of the mandate of the Standing Rapporteur, which will be sent to Coordinators for endorsement.

**3. Appointment of moderators for the hearings to be organised in the second half of 2023**

*Decision:*

- The DEVE hearing on a 'Team Europe initiative: saving the Congo Basin and providing development opportunities for Congo Basin countries' will be moderated by the EPP and the Greens/EFA.

- The DEVE hearing on the ‘State of play on the EU-Africa strategy in a new global setting’ will be moderated by S&D.

#### **4. DEVE’s participation in the European Gender Equality Week**

*Decision:* DEVE to participate to the fourth edition of the European Gender Equality Week in October 2023.

#### **5. Organisation of the High Level Geopolitical Dialogue on NDICI - Global Europe**

*Decision:*

It is agreed to discontinue the "questions submission format" and to continue the organisation of the debate in different sessions. It is also agreed to plan an additional High Level Geopolitical Dialogue in the spring of 2024, in addition to the next one planned for 7 November 2023.
