Highlights

Exchange of views with the Commission on disruptions in the internal market in the context of farmers' protests



The recent large-scale protests by farmers concerned about their future and livelihoods have also led to blockages on the borders, destructive actions and disruptions in logistics chains in many corners of the Union. The AGRI Committee has invited the Commission to discuss how the situation should be addressed in the context of the free movement of goods and which measures could be taken at the national as well as at the Union level.

Simplification to reduce the burden for EU farmers

The Commission will present to the AGRI Committee the next steps and envisaged measures to reduce the burden for farmers in the context of global farmers' protest in the EU. After a first consultation of Member States and mains EU farmers' organisations, the Commission has published last Thursday 22 February 20024, a first assessment of the situation with possible actions. Along the measures, the Commission may propose a revision of CAP regulations, adaptation to delegated and implanting acts, action toward national administrations, studies and a public consultation. Members will exchange with the Commission and precise their views and priorities.

The Committee on Agriculture and Rural Development will adopt its opinions on the extension of temporary trade liberalisation measures in favour of, respectively, Ukraine and Moldova.
