Note from the Chair



As each year, International Women's Day is the moment in year where we get together and celebrate progress made in terms of women's rights and gender equality, as well as looking forward to those challenges that remain. This year, my committee has decided to underline the importance of empowering women and girls through education. Whilst many countries have made significant progress towards gender equality in education, the picture is still mixed.

Education and training of women remains as a key area of concern within the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action, the agenda for women empowerment that will be reviewed again this year, 20 years after its adoption. With gender equality and women's rights at the

heart of addressing unfinished commitments of the Millennium Development Goals and global development beyond 2015, it is important, and timely given the political momentum of reviewing these international instruments, to address education in this context. Despite a greater presence of girls in classrooms in developing countries, their attendance rates are poorer than that of boys and girls are less likely to achieve primary education or to progress to secondary education with challenges faced including poverty, violence against women, child marriage and teenage pregnancy and discriminatory social norms or traditions. Within the European Union, women continue to be underrepresented in fields of science, technology, engineering and mathematics, as well as in management, government and other decision-making posts. The FEMM Committee strongly believes education is a tool to challenge those gender stereotypes that continue to influence girls' academic choices, school curricula, their self-perception and expectations; all aspects that reinforce gender inequalities and gender segregation of labour markets.



Empowering Women and Girls through EducationInterparliamentary committee meeting

The main event organised by the FEMM Committee, in collaboration with the Directorate for Relations with National Parliaments and the Directorate for Democracy Support, will be the **interparliamentary committee meeting organised on 5 March from 09.00 to 12.30**. In the presence of Members of the national parliaments of the EU Member States, the enlargement countries and the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe, Members of the Committee will discuss the topic of "Empowering Women and Girls through Education."

The event will be divided into three discussion panels that are to analyse issues such as the importance of eliminating gender disparity in education and training, challenges for equal access to continuous and quality education and finally concrete actions to move towards the empowerment of women and girls through education within the European Union. The panels will include a large range of prominent guests such as: the European Commissioner for Justice, Consumer and Gender Equality, Věra Jourová, representatives of UNICEF, but also the European Digital Girl of the Year 2014, Manon Van Hoorebeke. Amongst others, Members have also invited experts from the ground, as Dulce Rebelo from Portugal (Movimento Democrático das Mulheres) and Stanimira Hadjimitova from Bulgaria (Gender Project for Bulgaria Foundation).



Annual seminar for journalists at the occasion of IWD

Prior to the meeting, the European Parliament press services organise a networking conference for journalists on "Empowering women and girls through education".
