

The organisation of the jointhearing at the request of CONT, JURI, AFCO and LIBE committees is a good opportunity to allow a deep discussion at the European Parliament level about crucial issues of accountability, transparency and integrity of the EU institutions and about possible further developments related these issues.

Considering the improvements made by the

European Commission to the applicable revised Code of Conduct for Commissioners, and the critical analysis of the Parliament, one of the main objective for the CONT, JURI, AFCO, LIBE Members would be to find out if there is still room for further development and to what extent the accepted and implemented improvements achieved by the Commission could be used to increase the level of transparency within other European institutions and consequently the trust of EU citizens. Furthermore, the promotion of highest standards of integrity within the EU institutions, particularly the ethical questions regarding lobbying practices and transparency register, as well as the ways of preventing corruption in the EU represent keymatters of interest that will be dealt with during this jointhearing.

On this occasion, the key conclusions of the Transparency International Report on 'the European Union Integrity System', the first ever comprehensive review of corruption and integrity risks in the EU institutions, will also be presented.

Eight participants are invited to give their views on these issues and to identify possible ways to further developments:
