

## Tasks of the Marechaussee at Schiphol

- -Border control
- -Police task, including criminal investigation
- -High risk security of civil aviation
- -Supervision of (private) security process
- -Expulsion of aliens

Under the authority of the Ministry of Security and Justice





## Developments Schiphol airport

- From 55 mln passengers today to 70 mln in 2020
- Use of larger airplanes, more passengers at the same time
- More transit passengers from more countries
- More competition from non EU airports





### **EU Airborders**

Schiphol (and other EU airports) is a hub:

-Interest of the airport: mobility

-Interest of the passenger: mobility

-Interest of Marechaussee: effective border control

Challenge: balance between mobility and security





## Challenges in the Border Control Task

Growing number of passengers and focus on hostmanship means <u>need for innovation</u> to:

- -uphold and improve level of mobility
- -uphold and improve level of border control

without a growing number of border guards or possibilities for expansion of the airport.





## Use of technique at the Schiphol air border





#### What do we need?

- -The border guards need systems that take over simple tasks enabling them to focus on the overall process: entry exit.
- -Smart, innovative solutions that enable us to handle more passengers, through quicker and more efficient procedures such as ABC gates.
- -Information driven border control
- -The border guards need to check different systems, such as VIS, SIS and SLTD. Interoperability is needed!
