<u>Consideration of a draft report</u>

The rapporteur will present her own-initiative draft report.

Family businesses make up to more than 60% of all European companies, encompassing a vast range of firms of different sizes and from different sectors.

Discussion will focus if family owned companies face specific challenges that

hamper their growth and development and which future policy initiatives at EU-level are needed.

Adoption of a draft report



The committee will vote on the draft report on Green growth and Business Opportunities for SMEs.

In total, 183 amendments were tabled to this own initiative report and 25 compromise amendments were proposed by the rapporteur.

The BUDG and REGI committees have provided their opinions.

Investment Plan Package

Adoption of a draft opinion

The Committee will vote on the draft opinion on the Regulation setting up the European Fund for Strategic Investments (EFSI) and the accompanying Amending Budget.

In total 536 amendments were tabled to the Commission proposal but several Compromise Amendments have been proposed by the Rapporteur ahead of the vote.

In this legislative procedure ITRE is an Associated Committee with exclusive competences on Article 5.2, 18 and 19 of the Regulation.

The lead Committees, BUDG and ECON, are expected to vote jointly on April 20.



Copyright and related rights in the information society

<u>Adoption of a draft opinion</u>

The committee will vote on a draft opinion on the implementation of Directive 2001/29/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May 2001 on the harmonisation of certain aspects of copyright and related rights in the information society ("Infosoc" Directive).

In total, 134 amendments were tabled to the draft opinion and 11 compromise amendments were proposed by the draftsperson.

Limitation of emissions of certain pollutants into the air from medium combustion plants

<u>Adoption of a draft opinion</u>

The committee will vote on the draft opinion on limitation of emissions of certain pollutants into the air from medium combustion plants.

In total, 185 amendments were tabled to the draft opinion and 8 compromise amendments were proposed by the draftsperson.



Trade Secrets(Draftsperson: Michele Rivasi)

Adoption of a draft opinion

The Committee will vote on the draft opinion Protection of undisclosed know-how and business information (trade secrets) against their unlawful acquisition, use and disclosure, for which JURI is the lead Committee.

In ITRE, 278 amendments were tabled to the Commission proposal. However, 24 Compromise Amendments have been proposed by the Rapporteur.



Blue Economy: realising potential seas/oceans for jobs & growth

Consideration of a draft report

The Committee will be considering the Draft Report concerned with exploiting research and development potential in the blue economy to create jobs and growth. The report is ITRE's response to the recent Commission Communication on Innovation in the Blue Economy: realising the potential of our seas and oceans for jobs and growth.

Blue Economy is very relevant to several of ITRE's areas of competence, particularly natural resources, energy and SMEs.

In his draft report, the Rapporteur makes several proposals, including, amongst others, a request for clear-cut objectives and time-frames to be laid down with a view to making marine data more accessible.




Green paper on capital Markets Union, Jonathan Hill, Commissioner Financial Stability, Financial Services and Capital Markets Union

The Commissioner Hill will present and discuss with Members the Green Paper on Capital Markets Union, published by the Commission on 18 February 2015.

This Green Paper started a three month consultation, during which the Commission will consult Members of the European Parliament, Member States, stakeholders in capital markets and from all groups concerned. On the basis of the outcome of this consultation, the Commission will consider the priority actions needed to develop a fully functioning Capital Markets Union by 2019.

Objective of the ITRE Committee would be to obtain more information in particular about how to improve access to finance and widen the investor base for SMEs, as well as how to boost long-term investments in the EU.



Public hearing on "The Internal Energy Market as a Pillar for Energy Union"

The ITRE Committee will conduct a public hearing on 20 April 2015 entitled: "The Internal Energy Market as a Pillar for Energy Union". This is

the first ITRE hearing following the Communication on a Strategy for a European Energy Union in February 2015 and is a follow up to the European Parliament's resolution of 10 September 2013 on making the internal energy market work, with ITRE Chair, Mr Jerzy Buzek, as the rapporteur.

The hearing will address two issues in particular. Firstly; the integration of electricity and gas markets and solutions to eliminate obstacles and how Energy Union could enhance energy security. Secondly; the role of domestic energy production, securing interconnections, the market for electricity from renewables, and markets aspects of reduction of emissions.

The hearing will be an important opportunity to enhance the understanding of the problems involved and hear a variety of opinions. Five speakers have been invited for this purpose:
