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
An example for the plurality of religion: German classrooms, 2014

background



Challenges resulting from the religious context



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1. Against the tendency of privatization of religion – towards a public, rational discourse of religion
2. Against displacing religion from educational institutions – towards an interreligious education

Arguments for the public discourse of religion



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- Jürgen Habermas: Plea for translating the potential of rationality and meaning in the religions into society.
- These translations need to be performed by religions as well as by societies (!) in order to preserve a „sense of humanity“ within functioning democracies
- Democracies are in charge to create a place for these translations also in educational institutions.

Concept of Education by PISA (Jürgen Baumert)



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- Education as a multi-dimensional phenomenon
- Philosophy and religion as genuine modes to discover reality


Schools needs to provide opportunities for approaching reality from a religious perspective

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

- What is the contribution of religions to empower people of different cultures and nations to live together in peace?


to realize that religion is an identity marker esp. of people with migration background and of refugees
