PROCEDURAL PAGE

At the sitting of 15 March 2001 Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the proposal for a European Parliament and Council directive concerning life assurance (COM(2000) 398 - 2000/0162 (COD)).

At the sitting of 30 May 2002 the President of Parliament announced that the common position had been received and referred to the Committee on Legal Affairs and the Internal Market (7328/1/2002 - C5-0230/2002).

The committee had appointed The Lord Inglewood rapporteur at its meeting of 13 September 2000.

It considered the common position and draft recommendation for second reading at its meetings of 19 June 2002, 10 July 2002 and 10 September 2002

At the last meeting it adopted the draft legislative resolution unanimously.

DRAFT LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION

European Parliament legislative resolution on the Council common position for adopting a European Parliament and Council directive concerning life assurance (7328/1/2002 – C5-0230/2002 – 2002/0162(COD))

(Codecision procedure: second reading)

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the Council common position (7328/1/2002 C5-0230/2002),
- having regard to its position at first reading¹ on the Commission proposal to Parliament and the Council ((COM(2000) 398²),
- having regard to Article 251(2) of the EC Treaty,
- having regard to Rule 78 of its Rules of Procedure,
- having regard to the recommendation for second reading of the Committee on Legal Affairs and the Internal Market (A5-0287/2002),
- 1. Approves the common position;
- 2. Notes that the act is adopted in accordance with the common position;
- 3. Instructs its President to sign the act with the President of the Council pursuant to Article 254(1) of the EC Treaty;
- 4. Instructs its Secretary-General duly to sign the act and, in agreement with the Secretary-General of the Council, to have it published in the Official Journal of the European Communities;
- 5. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council and Commission.
