By letter of 20 September 2002 the Council consulted Parliament, pursuant to Article 308 of the EC Treaty, on the proposal for a Council regulation concerning Community financial contributions to the International Fund for Ireland (2003-2004) (COM(2002) 472 - 2002/0210 (CNS)).


At the sitting of 23 September 2002 the President of Parliament announced that he had referred this proposal to the Committee on Regional Policy, Transport and Tourism as the committee responsible and the Committee on Budgets for its opinion (C5-0426/2002).

At its meeting of 8 October 2002, on a proposal from the chairman, the committee decided to approve the Commission proposal without amendment, pursuant to Rule 158(1) of the Rules of Procedure, and appointed its chairman rapporteur for this purpose.

(Consultation procedure)

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the Commission proposal to the Council (COM(2002) 472¹),
- having been consulted by the Council pursuant to Article 308 of the EC Treaty (C5-0426/2002),
- having regard to Rules 67 and 158(1) of its Rules of Procedure,
- having regard to the report of the Committee on Regional Policy, Transport and Tourism (A5-0335/2002),
- 1. Approves the Commission proposal;
- 2. Calls on the Council to notify Parliament should it intend to depart from the text approved by Parliament;
- 3. Asks to be consulted again should the Council intend to amend the Commission proposal substantially;
- 4. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council and Commission.
