#### PROCEDURAL PAGE

By letter of 11 December 2003 the Commission submitted to Parliament, pursuant to Articles 251(2) and 80(2) of the EC Treaty, the proposal for a European Parliament and Council regulation on the implementation of the International Safety Management Code within the Community (COM(2003) 767 - 2003/0291(COD)).


At the sitting of 15 December 2003 the President of Parliament announced that he had referred the proposal to the Committee on Regional Policy, Transport and Tourism as the committee responsible and the Committee on the Environment, Public Health and Consumer Policy for its opinion (C5-0627/2003).

At its meeting of 17 February 2004 the Committee on Regional Policy, Transport and Tourism decided, on a proposal from the chairman, to apply the simplified procedure under Rule 158(1), and the chairman was thus appointed rapporteur.

#### DRAFT EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION

on the proposal for a European Parliament and Council regulation on the implementation of the International Safety Management Code within the Community (COM(2003) 767 – C5-0627/2003 – 2003/0291(COD))

(Codecision procedure: first reading)

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the Commission proposal to the European Parliament and the Council (COM(2003) 767)<sup>1</sup>,
- having regard to Articles 251(2) and 80(2) of the EC Treaty, pursuant to which the Commission submitted the proposal to Parliament (C5-0627/2003),
- having regard to Rules 67 and 158(1) of its Rules of Procedure,
- having regard to the report of the Committee on Regional Policy, Transport and Tourism (A5-0074/2004),
- 1. Approves the Commission proposal;
- 2. Calls on the Commission to refer the matter to Parliament again if it intends to amend its proposal substantially or replace it with another text;
- 3. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council and Commission.
