Paragraph 22 to read as follows:

22. Deplores the fact that no specific framework on services has been established, although it welcomes the recommendations adopted, and urges all the members to submit revised, high-quality offers by the scheduled May 2005 deadline, with particular regard to those sectors and forms of supply which are of interest to the developing countries' exports (as provided for in Annex C of the Agreement); asks that the liberalisation of services of public interest be approached cautiously, asks that services related to health, education and the audio-visual sector be excepted and also those which concern people's basic needs, *such as water and energy*, as it is inappropriate to demand that the developing countries liberalise these services in a way which will lead to their being dismantled;
