**on the proposal for a regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EC) No 1177/2003 concerning Community statistics on income and living conditions (EU-SILC)  
(COM(2005)0028 – C6-0034/2005 – 2005/0004(COD))**

**(Codecision procedure: first reading)**

*The European Parliament,*

- having regard to the Commission proposal to the European Parliament and the Council (COM(2005)0028)<sup>1</sup>,
  - having regard to Article 251(2) and Article 285 of the EC Treaty, pursuant to which the Commission submitted the proposal to Parliament (C6-0034/2005),
  - having regard to Rules 51 and 43(1) of its Rules of Procedure,
  - having regard to the report of the Committee on Employment and Social Affairs (A6-0107/2005),
1. Approves the Commission proposal;
  2. Calls on the Commission to refer the matter to Parliament again if it intends to amend its proposal substantially or replace it with another text;
  3. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council and Commission.
