(4) Immigration liaison officers have to collect information concerning illegal immigration for use either at operational level or at strategic level, or both. Such information could substantially contribute to the FRONTEX Agency's activities related to risk analysis, and closer cooperation between the immigration liaison officers' networks and the FRONTEX Agency should be established to that effect.

(4) Immigration liaison officers have to collect information concerning illegal immigration for use either at operational level or at strategic level, ***including information indicating the Member States through which the illegal immigrants typically arrive and how long they remain before they are arrested.*** Such information could substantially contribute to the FRONTEX Agency's activities related to risk analysis, and closer cooperation between the immigration liaison officers' networks and the FRONTEX Agency should be established to that effect.
